**What is the Federal Post Card Application?**

The Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) is the primary form for requesting registration, address change, and/or an absentee ballot from your local election official. The FPCA acts as both a registration and absentee ballot request form. FVAP encourages our military voters to submit a new FPCA every year and when they move.

**Who is eligible to fill out the Federal Post Card Application?**

- A member of the Uniformed Services on active duty, or an eligible Family member
- A U.S. citizen residing outside of the U.S. temporarily; or
- A U.S. citizen residing outside of the U.S. indefinitely.
- May also apply to a member of the National Guard, in some States
