1. **SITUATION.** The Fort Hood Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP) in conjunction with the representatives from the Texas Department of Public Safety and Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) will host Substance Abuse Training **29 - 30 Jun 16** at Abrams Physical Fitness Center, Fort Hood, TX.

2. **MISSION.** Fort Hood Units provide support for ASAP Training **29 – 30 Jun 16** in order to provide Soldiers an increased awareness of the dangers associated with excessive drinking, as well as driving under the influence as Soldiers prepare to celebrate Independence Day.

3. **EXECUTION.**

(3) **1st Medical Brigade, 11th Signal Brigade, 48th Chemical Brigade:** Provide three Soldiers to setup ASAP equipment **290900 Jun 16** and teardown **301300 Jun 16** at Abrams Physical Fitness Center.

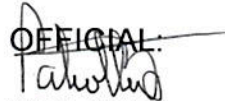
